Dear Parents,

We look forward to an exciting and very educational year with your child in grade 5. Following is a list of supplies your child will need for next year. The teachers would like all supplies sent to school and the teachers will distribute to your child his/her supplies as needed.

Grade Five Students are **required** to bring the following school supplies:

One 2 inch loose leaf binder (no bigger please)	2 boxes Kleenex (300's)
1 package of white paper (500 sheets) 8.5x11in.	1 - 30 centimetres (only) ruler (see through)
2 good quality small pencil sharpeners (one be with a container to catch shavings)	1 package dividers for binder
A 4 colour set of Expo chisel whiteboard dry-erase marker.	1 package of sticky notes 3 inch x 3 inch
1 package of 3 inch x 5 inch index cards.	2 Sharpie fine permanent marker - black
1 solar-powered calculator	3 red ballpoint/gel pens for marking work
1 pkg reinforcements	1 medium size pencil case
48 pencils	1 box pencil crayons (24)
6 erasers (white)	2 large UHU glue sticks 40g
1 roll of 19mm scotch tape or alternative	1 package of duo tang folders (4 folders with prongs)
1 large ziploc bag to store extra supplies in.	2 Highlighters
1 good quality pointed scissors (long blade, child size)	4 Hilroy Exercise 80 page (27.6 X 21.3 cm) notebooks -Red, Yellow, Blue, Green (no coils please)
1 small package washable felt pens assorted colours (no more than 12 pens needed)	1 set of headphones or ear buds in plastic sandwich sized Ziploc bag (cost under \$5.00)
3 good ballpoint/gel pens, blue or black (Bic, Sarasa or Papermate style)	1 Small water bottle (less than 1 litre)

1 pair inside shoes (runners) to be left at school. **Please purchase non-marking shoes for your children to wear at school. Some shoes are making huge black marks in our hallways and on our floors. This takes our caretakers a great deal of time to clean. Your help would greatly be appreciated. Thank-you.**

To avoid lost supplies, **print your child's name on everything (each item) with permanent ink.** All supplies should be sent with your child the **first day of school on Tuesday, September 3, 2019.** Some of these items may need to be replaced as they are used during the school year.

Parents who wish to bring additional items are invited to supply things like bingo daubers, any craft supplies (pompoms, google eyes, sidewalk chalk, etc.) spoons, forks, paper plates or cotton balls or ask your teacher for ideas.
